

CONCEPT NOTE

The EMAN-TUBA Conference on "Un/Governance in the Mediterranean Region and the Global System" will be held in Istanbul on 1-2 November 2025, marking the 80th anniversary of the establishment of the United Nations (UN). The conference is jointly organized by EMAN and TUBA's Working Group on International Relations.

The theme of the conference is "Un/Governance in the Mediterranean Region and the Global System," focusing on contemporary issues of governance and ungovernance in the global system and the Mediterranean region. The conference will mark the 80th anniversary of the UN, which is undoubtedly the most comprehensive governance organization in the modern era. Although there have been debates about the efficiency and effectiveness of the UN system, the UN, along with its various funds, programs, specialized agencies, and related organizations, has played a significant role in the governance of international relations at both regional and global levels.

We are faced with increasing global interdependence because of the new inventions and increased speed in transportation and telecommunication technologies, rendering the world as a "global village". On the other hand, those inventions and technologies simultaneously enhance regional cooperation and assertion. Furthermore, in addition to conventional challenges such as international security, war and peace, economic cooperation, regional and global transportation, and communication, etc., we are now faced with new challenges such as climate change, epidemics, migration, sustainability, environmental pollution, artificial intelligence, human security and cyber security, etc., to name but a few. Given the destructive capacity of states and non-state actors, and witnessing the increasing number of unilateral attempts, one may even speak of a state of ungovernance rather than governance in the global system. Yet the challenges we are faced with transcend the national and regional borders and thus global and regional cooperation and governance are inevitable for the sustainability of humanity and the planet.

This conference will deal with the said issues both at the global and Mediterranean levels and aim to provide a broad framework for scholars, policymakers and the public. It will form a platform for discussion of multiple practices from multiple perspectives. The themes of the conference will include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Global governance and regional governance: together or exclusive?
- The UN system: Evaluation and the need for reform?
- · Governance in security and the new challenges: terrorism, underground networks, cyber threats
- Governance in the economy, finance, and trade
- Governance in the energy sector and the security of supply chains
- Governance in health and epidemics
- · Governing human security and human rights
- States and non-state actors in global and regional governance
- Governance issues in the Mediterranean region: migration and refugees, navigation and transportation, climate change, environmental pollution, and sustainability
